Criteria for Evaluating Summer Soccer Camps

Occasionally, the T-CYSA is asked to pass on information about summer soccer camps. For T-CYSA to pass on information about this camp, questions 1-7 should be answered yes. The decision is made by VP of Development and communicated to the rest of the T-CYSA board. A copy of this guideline, with the written information about the camp and any necessary follow-up communication documented, will be kept on file at the T-CYSA office for a period of one year.

5. Does the coach plan to have trained first aid personnel on hand?	
6. Is there a medical release as part of the registration?	
7. Is emergency contact information gathered for each player?
